

OBITUARY.**DR. F. SHORT.**

Dr. Frederick Short, who died at Epping recently at the age of 55, gained his B.A. degree at the University of Sydney in 1908. He entered the Education Department, but resigned when he was 27. He gained his M.B. degree in 1916, and five years later he received the degree of Ch.M. Subsequently, he



was a resident medical officer at the (now Prince Henry) Coast, Crown Street, The Women's, and St. Vincent's Hospitals.

After practising for nine years at Parkes, Dr. Short went to London, where he studied radiology and electrology. He then went to Tasmania and practised in Macquarie Street, Hobart, as a radiologist for nine years. In 1934, Dr. Short gained the degree of Ll.B. at the University of Tasmania.

Dr. Short is survived by Mrs. Short and two sons.
